Glide straight into the core of the Costa Rican experience and hit two of Costa Rica's hot spots in a kayak. Beginners and more experienced kayakers are welcome - for the nature lover, the scenery's the point, not the sweat! Cruise through the canals of Tortuguero in search of monkeys and sloths, and then get really wild at Lake Arenal, the centre of adventure sports like paddle-boarding. Experience lush greenery and Caribbean flavour from a whole different level when you kayak Costa Rica.

What's Included

Guided kayaking sessions through the canals around Tortuguero (2 lessons, 2 hrs each). Guided hike through the jungle. Boat tour of Tortuguero National Park. Combo kayaking and stand-up paddle boarding session in Lake Arenal. Transport between destinations and to/from included activities.

Brief Itinerary

Day 1 San José

Arrive at any time.

Day 2 San José/La Fortuna

Travel from San José to La Fortuna, and opt to swim at a local swimming hole at the base of a waterfall during free time in the afternoon.

Day 3 La Fortuna

Take to the water and enjoy an included combo kayaking and stand-up paddle board session on Lake Arenal. Enjoy a free afternoon, and opt to go rafting, waterfall rappelling, or take a dip in therapeutic hot springs.

Day 4 La Fortuna

Enjoy a free day for adrenaline-fueled optionals such as the Cerro Chato extreme hike, whitewater rafting on Class III and IV rapids, waterfall rappelling or mountain biking. Or take it easy with some bird watching in Caño Negro Wildlife Refuge by boat or a massage in town.

Day 5 La Fortuna/Tortuguero (Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner)

Travel east through the rolling hills of the Central Valley towards the Caribbean coast, then transfer to a boat and motor through canals to arrive in Tortuguero at the jungle-lined coast of Costa Rica.

Day 6 Tortuguero (Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner)

Enjoy the first of two included guided kayaking excursions this morning, followed by free time in the afternoon. Opt for a nighttime excursion to look for nesting sea turtles laying eggs when it is turtle season.

Day 7 Tortuguero (Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner)

Enjoy the second guided kayak excursion through Tortuguero's jungle-lined canals in the morning and a guided jungle hike in the afternoon.

Day 8 Tortuguero/San José (Breakfast | Lunch)

Return to San José for an optional final night out with the group.

Day 9 San José
